Diving at Fuvahmulah

A Sanctuary of Tiger Sharks

Fuvahmulah, also known as Maldives' Shark Island, ranks as one of the **Best Shark Diving** destinations in the World. Since the construction of the harbor in 2004, fishermen have been discarding fish waste in the surrounding waters. This has given rise to a healthy population of curious Tiger Sharks that come up to feed. At peak time there are up to 5 to 10 individual sharks. The atoll's famous tiger sharks can be seen every day, but it is also home to hammerhead sharks, thresher sharks, silvertip sharks, big schools of barracudas, yellowfin tuna, bonitos and more.

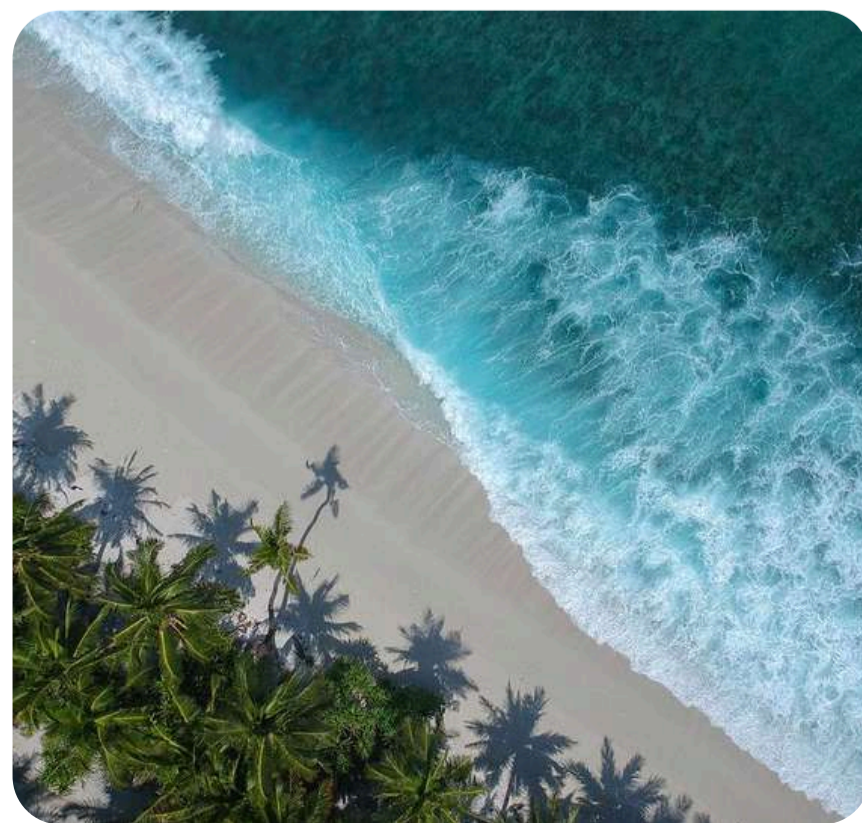
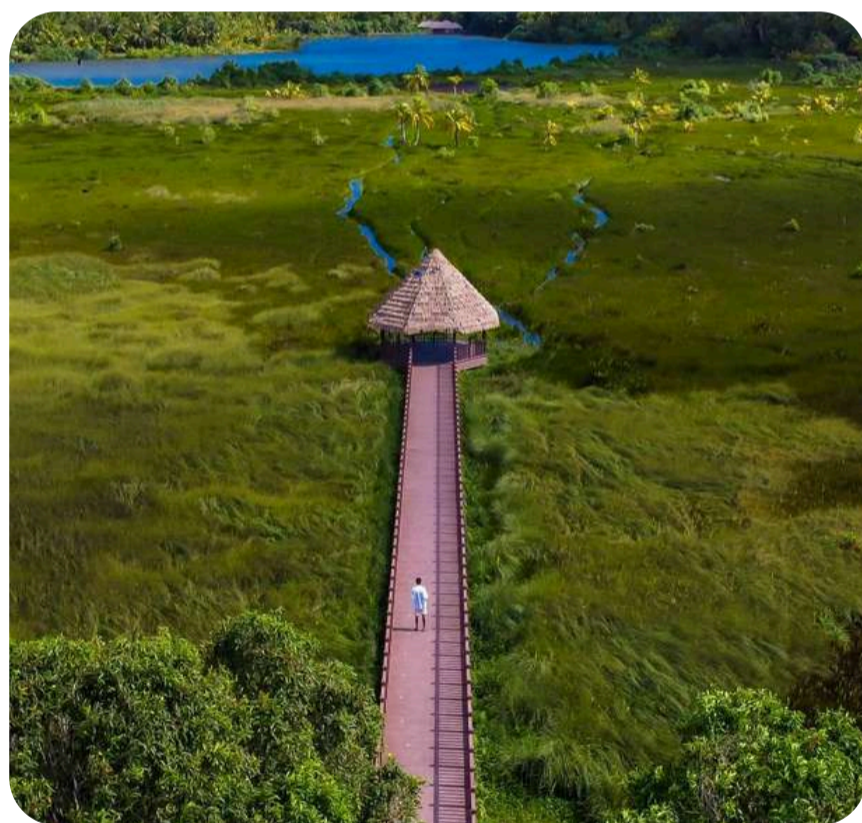


About the Island

UNESCO Biosphere Reserve since 2020

Fuvahmulah Island, located south of the equator in the Maldives, is a UNESCO-designated biosphere reserve unlike any other in the region. Known as the “Shark Island,” it offers unparalleled diving experiences, including daily encounters with Tiger Sharks. The island, about 4.5 km long and 1.2 km wide, is surrounded by waves ideal for surfers and lacks the typical lagoons found in the Maldives, bringing the house reef close to shore.

Beyond its marine treasures, Fuvahmulah features lush agricultural lands, making it the Maldives’ largest producer of mangoes and bananas. It is also home to two freshwater lakes surrounded by wetlands, a haven for birds and local wildlife. Thoondu Beach, adds to the island’s charm, making Fuvahmulah a truly unique and breathtaking destination.

TCS Rules

Tax collection at source, a mandatory advance tax applicable for Indian nationals for any foreign travel. If your cumulative payment(s) from April 1, 2024 for leisure foreign travel has crossed INR 7 lakh, a 20% TCS will be applicable on top of the trip fee. Otherwise, only 5% TCS will be charged (TCS is 100% Refundable/Reclaimable). TCS Refund can be claimed against the tax payable while filing ITR. It is shown in Form 26AS as a tax credit. NRIs are subject to 20% TCS on the total trip fee. TCS paid by NRIs is non-refundable.

- Both dive centers have been personally vetted by our dive experts. They are PADI 5-Star Centers with years of experience & an excellent safety record.
- Full set equipment rental includes a BCD, regulator, mask, fins, dive computer, and wetsuit.
