## Sogod Bay

### **Dive Sites & Marine Life Highlights**

The Philippines is home to the **second largest known population** of Whale Sharks in the world and Sogod Bay located on Leyte island has been an ethically protected Whale Shark hotspot for the 20+ years. These gentle giants are attracted to the plankton rich & krill filled waters enroute migration. Sogod has a great mix of dive sites (many within Marine Protected Areas) with different topography, all within a 1/2 hour boat ride of the resort – Adrian's **Cove, Zach's Cove, Napantao** boast endless pristine reefs.

Prime Dive Season : December to May (for Whale Sharks)














## Moalboal

### **Dive Sites & Marine Life Highlights**

The Sardine Run near Panagsama Beach at Moalboal is the second largest in the world and a must see natural wonder. Millions of sardines swirl in unison creating breathtaking moments for divers. Strict marine protection laws ensure thriving sardine schools here. Pescador island is a majestic uninhabitable island that boasts 450 species of hard coral and thousands of fish species such as pyramid butterflyfish, tuna, nudibranchs, snake eel, frog fish, barracuda.




## Malapascua

### **Dive Sites & Marine Life Highlights**


Malapascua is one of the only places in the world where divers can reliably see the elusive **Thresher Sharks**. They visit cleaning stations located in shallower depths at **Kimud Shoal**. Sunset dives here are famous for the special **Mandarin Fish mating dance ritual**. **Gato Island** is an uninhabited island located in a marine protected area. The dive sites here are thriving with soft coral gardens & offer great swim throughs that house sleeping white tip reef sharks. Divers also encounter bamboo sharks, sea snakes, seahorses, nudibranchs.

## Accomodation (1/3)

### Sogod Bay (3 Nights)

The beachside resort offers a breathtaking view of Sogod Bay and a coastline unmarred by urban development. Various amenities available include swimming pool, camera room, entertainment area including a terrace bar, darts board, billiards table, and mini gym. All rooms have WiFi, an ensuite bathroom, balcony / terrace, and offer ample storage space.

The resort's restaurant offers Asian & Western cuisines as well as beers and cocktails. The Roof Top area offers 360° views of the bay and mountains.













## Accomodation (2/3)

### Moalboal (3 Nights)

The swimming pool uses an environment friendly technology that reduces chemical use. The open air restaurant and pool bar offer Filipino delicacies, international cuisines, and fine drinks.













## Accomodation (3/3)

### Malapascua (4 Nights)

The resort is located on a small hill that descends into the private beach, an area isolated from the rest of the island that offers breathtaking sunsets. The resort design is environment friendly – materials are mostly all local: wood, bamboo, stone, cogon (straw) roofs. All rooms are tastefully furnishes with bamboo furniture, have a private terrace, and are equipped with all modern amenities such as WiFi, coffee, tea, minibar.

The resort has two restaurants that offer local & international cuisines with panoramic views of the ocean.











## **Dive Centres**

### **PADI 5 Dive Centers**

### $\stackrel{\wedge}{\swarrow}$ State of the art dive centers

All 3 dive centers are PADI 5 star dive centers with many years of experience operating in the respective areas. The dive center in Malapascua is a Green Fins certified PADI 5 Star IDC center.

### **Dedicated fleet of dive boats**

All 3 dive centers own and operate speed boats and local dive boats called Bangka. A Bangka boat is a local outrigger boat made of wood and outfitted with with bamboo outriggers to the sides for balance.

## **Example 7** Focus on marine conservation measures

All 3 dive centers operate in strictly regulated marine protected areas. Besides the regulated measures they contribute towards conservation by setting up and nurturing local reefs. The dive center

in Sogod Bay is also part of PADI Project Aware. The dive center in Malapascua is Green Fins certified.



A healthy diver to guide ratio is always maintained depending on the skill level of divers. All in-house boats are equipped with first aid kit, oxygen, and stretcher,



## Safety Infrastructure

### Dive Boats

Dive boats operated by all 3 dive centres are equipped with first aid kit, oxygen, stretcher, fire extinguisher, and life jackets. The dive centre in Sogod Bay also has an AED (Automated External Defibrillator) on all boats

### 🕝 Staff

All 3 dive resorts have dive guides and resort staff trained in Emergency First Response (EFR).

### **Dive Resorts**

The resort in Sogod Bay has a local clinic 5 mins away and a private hospital within 30 mins from the resort. All 3 dive resorts have a local private clinics located within 10 minutes from the respective resort.



### Hyperbaric Chamber

The nearest Hyperbaric Chamber from all 3 dive resorts is Cebu city. All 3 dive centres provide all available means of transport to ensure the impacted diver reaches the Hyberbaric chamber within 30 minutes.

The resort in Malapascua provides chopper services to the Hyperbaric chamber in case of emergencies.

### **Dive Insurance**

The Dive Resorts assist the divers in contacting DAN (or equivalent dive insurance agency) customer service, if required.

## **TCS Rules**

Tax collection at source, a mandatory advance tax applicable for Indian nationals for any foreign travel. If your cumulative payment(s) from April 1, 2024 for leisure foreign travel has crossed INR 7 lakh, a 20% TCS will be applicable on top of the trip fee. Otherwise, only 5% TCS will be charged (TCS is 100% Refundable/Reclaimable). TCS Refund can be claimed against the tax payable while filing ITR. It is shown in Form 26AS as a tax credit. NRIs are subject to 20% TCS on the total trip fee. TCS paid by NRIs is non-refundable.



- Indian passport holders with a valid visa or Permanent Residence Permit from the United States, United Kingdom, Canada, Australia, Japan, Singapore, Schengen country are eligible for Visa-Free entry to the Philippines up to 14 days extendable by seven days. Traveller must have a valid national passport for at least six (6) months, beyond the contemplated stay and a return or onward ticket.
- Indian nationals that do not fall in the above categories must apply for a visa at the Philippine Embassy or Philippine Consulate in the country of legal residence. Alternatively, they can also apply for a Singapore tourist visa which is quicker and easier to obtain.

### **Climate Types & Rainfall**


#### **Climate Types:**

The climate of the Philippines is tropical and maritime, characterized by relatively high temperatures, oppressive humidity, and plenty of rainfall. Based on the amount of rainfall there are 2 seasons in the country – the wet season (Jun to Nov) and the dry season (Dec to May).


- **Type I** two distinct seasons:wet season & dry season. Maximum rainfall is b/w Jun to Sep.
- **Type II** no dry season. March to May is the period with minimum monthly rainfall.
- **Type III** short dry season of 1 3 months between Dec to Feb or Mar to May depending on the region.
- **Type IV** rainfall is evenly distributed throughout the year.

## March and April are the months that offer the best of the dry season with minimal rainfall.



### **Typhoon Pattern & Best Diving Season**

#### The Philippines - Prone to Typhoons:



- Situated in the **typhoon belt of the western Pacific Ocean**, just above the equator.
- Affected by the **Coriolis Force**, which influences storms. The Coriolis effect makes storms swirl clockwise in the Southern hemisphere and counterclockwise in the Northern Hemisphere.
- A major **Storm Track** (narrow zones in the ocean where storms travel due to prevailing winds) runs through the area, causing storms that form in the Pacific to move west and hit the Philippines.
- Located in the **Pacific Ring of Fire**, which makes it vulnerable to earthquakes and volcanic eruptions.
- **Climate change** is causing higher sea surface temperatures, which increases the strength of typhoons.
- Based on data collected over 7 decades, July to November are the months where the most number of Tropical Cyclones enter and make landfall in the Philippines.

An objective analysis of the rhythm of rainfall combined with the Tropical Cyclone study and information on climate types in the Philippines, indicates that **March and April are the best months to dive in the Philippines** while **July to November must be avoided** as these lie in the wet season and are **heavily prone to strong typhoons**.
